Travel Training with Beaumont Pass Transit

Beaumont, CA—Forget about gas prices, traffic and paid parking, Beaumont Pass Transit will show you how to travel Southern California without a car!

Beaumont Pass Transit's Travel Training Program teaches riders how to utilize local public transportation to access major connection points and destinations. The 2019 program highlights connection to Los Angeles Union Station and Oceanside via Beaumont's Commuter Link 120 and Metrolink. Commuter Link 120 is Beaumont's newest compressed natural gas (CNG) bus and has capacity for twenty-four passengers and two wheelchairs.

In addition to featured destinations, Travel Training will provide information on connections to other regional transit options such as Omni Trans, RTA, Victor Valley Transit Agency and Mountain Transit. Connections with these regional transit providers opens the door to all southern California.
