- STREET BIKE LANES (PUBLIC HAZARDS)
- STREET LIGHTS (GENERAL OPERATION)
- STREET ROADWAY (CRACKS, POTHOLES, SINKHOLES, AND PUBLIC SAFETY CONCERNS)
- STREET SIGNS (WEATHERED, MISSING, OR OUTDATED)
- STREET STRIPING (WEATHERED OR MISSING)
- STREET TREES (PUBLIC HAZARD)
- WEED ABATEMENT (NON-LANDSCAPED AREAS WILL BE MAINTAINED BY PW)
